- Mother's Legal Name and Place of Birth and Country of Birth
- Mother's Maiden Name
- Name of Executor (if different)
- Address of Executor
- Telephone Number of Executor
- Executor's Email

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- Current Will
- Deceased Birth Certificate
- Deceased Social Insurance Card
- Spouse or Common-Law Birth Certificate
- Spouse of Common-Law Social Insurance Card
- Marriage Certificate or Certificate of Common-Law
- Cemetery Deed (if required)



ADDITIONAL ITEMS TO BRING WITH YOU:

- Photograph of the Deceased. (Please be sure to bring an original photo that has not already been scanned or cropped. Digital images can be sent to our email at: admin@jardinefuneralhome.com)
- Clothing including under garments.
